Compiler's Foreword. The indefinite article in the title is a disclaimer of complete coverage of Martin Franzmann's published writings. No doubt some have escaped us. We only note here, without listing below, the short lead articles that our expatriate colleague since 1970 has periodically written for the British Lutheran under the caption "Westfield's Window." Our chief concern has been to list his published books, his contributions to hymnody, and especially his numerous articles, chronologically arranged, that have appeared in the Concordia Theological Monthly and in the Lutheran Witness. Particularly his contributions to these two periodicals during two full decades have gained for him many enthusiastic aficionados among clergy as well as laity who hopefully look for continued literary productions of this exquisite writer and committed Biblical theologian.
