- L What does this mean?

- What is meant by daily bread?
- Daily bread includes everything that has to do with the support and needs of the body, such as food, drink, clothing, shoes, house, home, land, animals, money, goods, a devout husband or wife, devout children, devout workers, devout and faithful rulers, good government, good weather, peace, health, self-control, good reputation, good friends, faithful neighbors, and the like.
- Let us then give thanks to God for our daily bread. We pray. Almighty Father, maker of heaven and earth, for the food we have eaten today and the clothes we are wearing let us give thanks:
- We thank you for this, our daily bread.
- For the building we worship in let us give thanks:
- We thank you for this, our daily bread.

(Petitions may be offered by the people; at the end of each petition the people pray, "We thank you for this, our daily bread.")

For all of these things we give you thanks praying in the words given to us by your Son our Lord.
