He is a graduate of DOXOLOGY: The Lutheran Center for Spiritual Care and Counsel. He has served as Circuit Visitor (Wyoming and Missouri), as staff writer for *Good News* magazine, and on subcommittees for *Lutheran Service Book*. He has written Bible studies, devotional booklets and tracts for Concordia Publishing House. He has authored essays for *Lutheran Service Book: Companion to the Hymns* and the forthcoming *Lutheran Service Book: Companion to the Services*. He currently serves on the Council on Mission and Ministry of the Missouri District and is the host and producer of the short-form podcast *Sacred Meditations*. Pastor Asbury and his wife, Rachel, have two children, Christina and Jonathan.
