This year's lecturer in the Wenchel Foundation series is the Reverend Charles S. Mueller, pastor of the Lutheran Church of St. Andrew, Silver Spring, Maryland.

Reverend Mueller speaks on *Pastoral Preaching in the Parish* from a rich background. Currently, he is serving as First Vice-President of the Southeastern District of The Lutheran Church - Missouri Synod. He has served as Pastoral Advisor for the Lutheran Women's Missionary League - Chesapeake District and the Lutheran Laymen's League - Capital District, Chairman of the Public Relations Committee of the Southeastern District, and a member of the Southeastern District Evangelism Board.

After graduating from Concordia Seminary, St. Louis, Missouri, in 1953, he served as pastor of Bethlehem Lutheran Church, Jacksonville Beach, Florida (1953-1957), and has been at the Lutheran Church of St. Andrew since 1957. The Reverend Mr. Mueller is an author and lecturer at numerous seminars and conferences in various Districts of The Lutheran Church - Missouri Synod. Among his books are: *God's Wonderful World of Words* (1963), *A Christian Family Prepares for Christmas* (1965), and *The Strategy of Evangelism* (1965).

The Reverend Mueller and his wife Audrey Mae have four children: Sarah, Charles Jr., Amy, and Julianne.
