Warm up questions pre-video: (15 minutes)	
*	When we look up at the stars and the sky at night what do we see?
*	Where do we see man's place in the overall kingdom of God?
*	What is the difference between a person who deals in big pictures and a person who is detail-oriented?
*	What does "having dominion" mean in a worldly sense?
*	Read Genesis 1:26–30
*	What does "having dominion" mean according to Scripture?
*	Was man given the authority to be a steward of God's creation or to rule God's creation?
*	What can be lost as man becomes more dependent on technology?
*	Read Psalm 8

## Post-video follow up questions: (27 minutes)

- What does the psalmist attempt to teach us in Psalm 8?
- What is the first mystery that is revealed in the psalm?
- ❖ What does the psalmist point out in verses 1–4?
- Compared to the vastness of God's creation what does the psalmist ask in verse 4?
- ❖ Read Genesis 2:1–7
- What is the second mystery that is revealed in this psalm?
- ❖ What are the differences in Psalm 8 between verses 1–4 and 5–8?
- ❖ Read Genesis 3:1-6
